

Admissions for Academic Year 2026-27

Eligibility Criteria

- Children born between **02/06/2022** and **01/06/2023** are eligible to apply.
- Only those students who satisfy the school's age eligibility criteria will be eligible for admission.
- Required documents: Child's Birth Certificate, Address Proof, 03 Passport-size Photographs of the child and parents, Photocopies of PAN Cards of both the parents, Aadhar Card (if available).

Admission Process

- Enquiry forms will be available online and at the school office from 27/10/2025 onwards (09:00 am to 01:00 pm, Monday to Saturday).

- 2. Interaction sessions with parents and children will be scheduled from 03/11/2025 onwards.
- 3. Parents will be informed via phone and email regarding the Interaction schedule.
- 4. Post interaction, parents will be guided to submit the Admission Form along with the required documents to the School Office.
- 5. Once your child has been granted admission, you will be required to confirm the seat by paying the applicable fees as advised by the Admissions Office within a period of 3 working days.
- 6. On payment of the fees, you will be given a receipt which will confirm your child's admission to the school.

- Admissions will be strictly as per the government guidelines and priority will be given to local students, siblings students (not cousins) and alumni children, wherever applicable.
- Incomplete or incorrect applications are liable to be rejected.
